CHAPTER 303 HOUSE BILL 766

AN ACT TO PERMIT MUNICIPALITIES BORDERING ON THE ATLANTIC OCEAN AND ROANOKE, ALBEMARLE, OR CURRITUCK SOUND TO REGULATE SEWER TIE-ONS WITHIN THEIR CORPORATE LIMITS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 160A-196 reads as rewritten:

"**§ 160A-196. Sewage tie-ons.**–Cities that (in whole or in part) are adjacent to, adjoining, intersected by or bounded by the Atlantic Ocean and <u>Roanoke, Albemarle,</u> <u>Currituck, or Pamlico Sound may by ordinance regulate the tie-ons to sewage systems within their corporate limits."</u>

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 8th day of June, 1987.
