HOUSE BILL 357

AN ACT TO REPEAL PROVISIONS OF THE GENERAL STATUTES
AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION TO INSPECT MINES
IN WHICH CONVICTS ARE EMPLOYED AND REQUIRING THE
DEPARTMENT TO ESTABLISH A REVOLVING FUND FOR LOANS TO
PRISONERS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 148-7 is repealed.

Sec. 2. G.S. 148-18(c) is repealed.

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
