CHAPTER 38
HOUSE BILL 372

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE MADISON COUNTY BOARD OF
EDUCATION SHALL TAKE OFFICE IN JULY OF THE YEAR OF THEIR
ELECTION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 5 of Chapter 249 of the 1991 Session Laws reads as
rewritten:

"Sec. 5. The terms of office of the members and chairman of the Madison County
Board of Education commence on the first Monday in ~~December~~ July of the year of
their ~~election~~ election, except if that date is the Fourth of July, then the terms
commence on the second Monday in July."

Sec. 2. Terms of office of members of the Madison County Board of
Education elected in 1994 for two-year terms expire on the first Monday in July of
1996. Terms of office of members of the Madison County Board of Education elected
in 1994 for four-year terms expire on the first Monday in July of 1998. The term of
office of the chairman of the Board of Education of Madison County elected in 1994 for
a four-year term expires on the first Monday in July of 1998.

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 17th day of
April, 1995.
