HOUSE BILL 1615

AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE AUTHORITY OF THE COUNTY OF DURHAM TO
FUND THE ESTABLISHMENT OF BIKEWAYS AND TRAILS THROUGHOUT
THE COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 136-71.12 reads as rewritten:

"§ 136-71.12. Funds.

The General Assembly hereby authorizes the Department to include needed funds for the program in its annual budgets for fiscal years after June 30, 1975, subject to the approval of the General Assembly.

The Department is authorized to spend any federal, State, local or private funds available to the Department and designated for the accomplishment of this Article. ~~Cities and towns~~ Cities, towns, and counties may use any funds available."

Section 2. This act applies to the County of Durham only.

Section 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 11th day of August, 1998.
