SESSION LAW 2011-109 SENATE BILL 155

AN ACT TO ALLOW THE TOWNS OF GARNER, KNIGHTDALE, MORRISVILLE, WENDELL, AND ZEBULON AND THE CITIES OF DURHAM AND WINSTON-SALEM TO COLLECT DELINQUENT STORMWATER UTILITY FEES IN THE SAME MANNER AS THEY MAY COLLECT DELINQUENT PERSONAL AND REAL PROPERTY TAXES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Section 4 of S.L. 2005-441 reads as rewritten:

"SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to stream-clearing activities commenced on or after that date. Section 3 of this act applies only to the <u>Cities of Durham and Winston-Salem</u>, the <u>TownTowns</u> of <u>Garner</u>, <u>Kernersville</u>, <u>Kernersville</u>, <u>Knightdale</u>, <u>Morrisville</u>, <u>Wendell</u>, and <u>Zebulon</u>, and the Village of Clemmons."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law. In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 8th day of June, 2011.
