**SESSION LAW 2011-32  
SENATE BILL 46**

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A SEASON FOR THE TAKING OF FOXES AND COYOTES IN  
SURRY COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, there is an open season for taking foxes and coyotes with lawful weapons or traps from October 15 through March 1 of each year.

**SECTION 2.** No season bag limit applies to foxes and coyotes taken under this act.

**SECTION 3.** This act applies only to Surry County and Alleghany County.

**SECTION 4.** This act is effective when it becomes law.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 7<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2011.
