**SESSION LAW 2021-139  
HOUSE BILL 229**

AN ACT TO EXTEND THE TERM OF MAYOR FROM TWO TO FOUR YEARS IN THE  
TOWN OF CAROLINA SHORES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Section 3.4 of the Charter of the Town of Carolina Shores, being S.L. 1998-75, as amended by Town Ordinance No. 19-6 adopted December 6, 2018, reads as rewritten:

"Sec. 3.4. **Selection of Mayor; Term of Office.** The qualified voters of the entire Town elect the Mayor ~~Theodora Altreuter shall serve as Mayor to serve until the organizational meeting after the 1999 municipal election. A Mayor shall be elected in 1999 and biennially thereafter for a two-year term to serve a four-year term.~~"

**SECTION 2.** The Brunswick County Board of Elections shall reopen the filing period for the office of Mayor for the Town of Carolina Shores for a period to run from September 7, 2021, to September 10, 2021.

**SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law, and municipal elections in 2021 and thereafter shall be held accordingly.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of September, 2021.
