## SESSION LAW 2023-85 SENATE BILL 246

AN ACT TO AMEND WHAT CONSTITUTES THE CRIME OF SECOND DEGREE TRESPASS TO INCLUDE ENTERING OR REMAINING ON THE CURTILAGE OF A DWELLING BETWEEN THE HOURS OF MIDNIGHT AND 6:00 A.M.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

## **SECTION 1.** G.S. 14-159.13 reads as rewritten:

## "§ 14-159.13. Second degree trespass.

- (a) Offense. A person commits the offense of second degree trespass if, without authorization, he the person enters or remains on premises of another: on any of the following:
  - (1) After he On premises of another after the person has been notified not to enter or remain there by the owner, by a person in charge of the premises, by a lawful occupant, or by another authorized person; or person.
  - (2) That On premises that are posted, in a manner reasonably likely to come to the attention of intruders, with notice not to enter the premises.
  - On the curtilage of a dwelling of another between the hours of midnight and 6:00 A.M.
- (b) Classification. Second degree trespass is a Class 3 misdemeanor. Penalties. A violation of subdivision (a)(1) or (a)(2) of this section is a Class 3 misdemeanor. A violation of subdivision (a)(3) of this section is a Class 2 misdemeanor."

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2023, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
