Charter	PrL1873-102	An Act to Incorporate the Town of Cerro Gordo, in the County of Columbus.
	PrL1874-119	Amended PrL1873-102 to change the names of the persons appointed as Town Commissioners.
Revised & Consolidated	PrL1907-516	An Act to Incorporate the Town of Cerro Gordo, in Columbus County. *Section 52 of this act repealed "all laws heretofore passed for the better government and regulation of the said town of Cerro Gordo."
Section 2 of PrL1907-516	PrL1921-46 Extra Session	Amended Section 2 (corporate limits).
	PrL1929-175	Amended Section 2 (corporate limits) of PrL1907-516 by revising Section 1 of PrL1921-46 Extra Session.
Section 3 of PrL1907-516	1973-779	This act effectively amended Section 3 of PrL1907-516 by appointing four named persons to serve as Town Commissioners, and one to serve as Town Mayor. Also, the act provided for the manner in which the next election in November, 1973 was to be conducted.
	1973-1044	This act further amended Section 3 of PrL1907-516 by increasing the number of Commissioners from four to five (and naming the fifth Commissioner in the act); also extended the terms of office of the Commissioners to four years and the Mayor to two years (Section 3 of PrL1907-51 provides that elections are to be held annually).
