Chapter 375 of the Private Laws of 1901

Charter	PrL1901-375	An Act to Incorporate the Town of Dover, in the County of Craven.
Section 1	<a href="#">1969-411</a>	Amended Section 1 to allow the Town to require connections to the Town water system. *See G.S. 160A-317 for general law on this topic.
Section 2	PrL1909-301	Amended Section 2 (corporate limits).
Section 2.1	2021-39	Added Section 2.1 which provided that the mayor and 5 commissioners shall be the governing body of the Town, and shall each serve for a term of two years.

Section 2.2	2021-39	Added Section 2.2 which provided that Town elections shall be held in even-numbered years, beginning in 2022. No elections shall be held in 2021.
