Chapter 23 of the Private Laws of 1913 (Extra Session)

Charter	PrL1913-23 Extra Session	An Act to Incorporate the Town of Dublin, in Bladen County.
Re-activated Charter	1951-509	This act provided that the Town of Dublin continued to be a body politic, described the Town's corporate limits, and appointed certain individuals to serve as Mayor and commissioners (3).
Section 2 of 1951-509	1955-341	Amended Section 2 of S.L. 1951-509 to correct the description of the Town's corporate limits.
	1987-66	Amended Section 2 of S.L. 1951-509 to restate the Town's corporate limits.
Section 3 of PrL1913-23 Extra Session	1985-17	Deleted "a town constable, regular and special policemen" to bring the Town under the general law relating to the appointment of police.
Section 4 of PrL1913-23 Extra Session	1985-17	Deleted "town constable," "and regular policemen", "and the special policemen shall be appointed by the mayor" to bring the Town under the general law relating to the appointment of police.
Section 7 of PrL1913-23 Extra Session	1985-17	Repealed Section 7 (related to town constable powers) to bring the Town under the general law relating to the appointment of police.
