Charter	PrL1905-239	An Act to Incorporate the Town of Hudson, in Caldwell County.
Section 1	1949-426	Amended Section 1 (Town incorporated) to make technical correction.
	1949-1089	Repealed changes made in 1949-426.
Section 2	<a href="#">1965-1050</a>	Rewrote Section 2 (description of corporate limits). This act does not say it's rewriting Section 2, but that appears to be the intent.
	<a href="#">1967-322</a>	Rewrote Section 3 (officers). This act does not say it's rewriting Section 3, but that appears to be the intent.
Section 3	<a href="#">Ord No. 1-3-1984</a>	The Town amended the Charter to change the form of government from "mayor-council" to "council-manager".
	1949-426	Amended Section 4 (officers named; term of office).
Section 4	1949-1089	Repealed changes made in 1949-426.
	1951-647	Amended the Charter to provide that all election shall be held in accordance with general law (then Chapter 160).
Section 5	Ord No. 3-21-23	The Town amended Section 4 of the Charter to provide that the Mayor shall serve a four-year term.
	1949-426	Amended Section 5 (tax rate).
Section 6	1949-1089	Repealed changes made in 1949-426.
	1949-426	Amended Section 6 (Mayor's court).
