Chapter 282 of the Private Laws of 1911

Charter	PrL1911-282	An Act to Incorporate the Town of Lake Waccamaw, in Columbus County.
Section 2	1957-758	Amended Section 2 by extending the Town's corporate boundaries.
	1959-409	Rewrote Section 2.
Section 4	1967-14	Amended Section 4 (Town officers) to provide that the governing board (as of the election in May, 1967) shall consist of a Mayor and four commissioners. Mayor shall serve a term of two years. Commissioners shall serve four-year terms, which shall be staggered. Section also provides for the manner in which vacancies in the office of Mayor and commissioner shall be filled.
	Ord No. 6-9-2009	The Town amended Section 4 of the Charter, pursuant to G.S. 160A-101 and G.S. 160A-102, to extend the Mayor's term from two to four years.
