

Charter of the Town of Lasker (Northampton)
 Chapter 281 of the Private Laws of 1895
 (PrL = Private Laws; PL = Public-Local Laws)

Charter	PrL1895-281	An Act to Incorporate the Town of Lasker, in Northampton County.
Section 3	PrL1929-167	Amended Section 3 to reduce the number of commissioners from five to three. Also changed "town constable" to "town marshal." In addition to commissioners, the Town shall have an elected Mayor.
	PL1939-48	Rewrote Section 3 to provide that the town shall have a mayor, three commissioners, a town constable, tax collector, clerk, and treasurer.
Section 4	PL1939-48	Rewrote Section 4 to provide that Town elections shall be held every two years for the purpose of electing a Mayor and three commissioners.
