

Charter of the Town of Mars Hill (Madison)
Chapter 890 of the Session Laws of 1953

Charter	1953-890	An Act to Amend, Revise and Consolidate the Statutes that Constitute the Charter of the Town of Mars Hill.
Article I Section 5	Ord No.# 168 (3/6/2008)	The Town, pursuant to G.S. 160A-101 and G.S. 160A-102, amended Section 5 of the charter to provide that the Town shall be governing by a board of aldermen consisting of 4 members and a mayor (who shall have voting rights – the ordinance doesn't specify voting rights; presumably voting on all matters before the board). The terms of the aldermen shall be staggered four-year terms, beginning in 2009.
	2023-112	Amended Section 5 of Article I, as amended by Town Ordinance 168, to provide that the mayor shall be elected for a four-year term and the board members shall be elected for staggered four-year terms.
Article VII Section 1	2023-112	Amended Section 1 of Article VII to provide that elections shall be held in odd-numbered years and shall be partisan.
Article VII Sections 2-12	2023-112	Repealed Sections 2-12 of Article VII (sections related to Town elections).
