

Charter of the Town of Ranlo (Gaston)
Chapter 776 of the Session Laws of 1963

Charter	1963-776	An Act to Incorporate the Town of Ranlo in Gaston County, State of North Carolina.
Section 2	1969-661	Rewrote Section 2 (description of the Town's corporate limits).
Section 6	Ord No. # 2009-02-12	The Town, pursuant to G.S. 160A-101 and G.S. 160A-102, amended Section 6 of the Charter to extend the terms of the members of the board of commissioners and the Mayor from two to four years.
	Ord No. 2020-3-12	The Town, pursuant to G.S. 160A-101 and G.S. 160A-102, amended Section 6 of the Charter to change the form of government from mayor-council to council-manager.
Section 11	1969-661	Rewrote subdivision (3) of Section 11 (purchases by Town).
	Ord No. # 2009-02-12	The Town, pursuant to G.S. 160A-101 and G.S. 160A-102, amended Section 11 of the Charter to provide that the board shall "hire" rather than "appoint" Town employees.
	Ord No. 2020-3-12	The Town, pursuant to G.S. 160A-101 and G.S. 160A-102, amended Section 11 of the Charter to allow for the appointment of a Town Manager (the ordinance changed the form of government from mayor-council to council-manager, and thus the Town will henceforth require the appointment of a Manager by the Town Council).
Section 12	1965-23	Repealed Section 12 (authorized Gastonia to annex entire Town of Ranlo).

Local Acts Not in Charter

Annexation	1987-256	Added certain described property to the Town's corporate limits.
	2003-30	Provided that the Town is not subject to the 10% limitation on satellite annexations (See G.S. 160A-58.1(b)(5)).
Occupancy Tax	2009-429	Authorized the Town to levy a room occupancy and tourism development tax.
