

Charter of the Town of Raynham (Robeson)  
Chapter 388 of the Session Laws of 1975

Charter	1975-388	An Act to Incorporate the Town of Raynham in Robeson County.
	2017-58	Validated elections in the Town since May 26, 1975 notwithstanding any irregularities; validated the actions of the board of commissioners since May 26, 1975 notwithstanding any irregularities in the manner of the election.
Section 3	1977-16	Amended Section 3 to reduce the number of commissioners from five to three. The Mayor shall serve a two-year term.
	2017-58	Amended Section 3 to provide for the election of the Town commissioners for a four-year term, and to provide that the Mayor shall serve a four-year term.
Section 4	1977-16	Amended Section 4 to reduce the number of commissioners from five to three, and to stagger their four-year terms, beginning with the regular municipal elections in 1979.
	1977-270	Amended Section 4, as amended in 1977-16, to change the effective date of the election changes from 1979 to 1977.
***	Ord No. # 2015-05-19	The Town, pursuant to G.S. 160A-101 and G.S. 160A-102, amended the Charter to extend the terms of the members of the Town commissioners from two to four years. *In acts passed by the General Assembly, the commissioners' terms were always 4 years, thus unclear why Town enacted this ordinance – perhaps there was an ordinance that changed the terms but it is not on the SOS website.
