

Charter of the Town of Robbins (Moore)
Chapter 63 of the Private Laws of 1935

Charter	PrL1935-63	An Act to Incorporate the Town of Hemp and to Confer Upon its Officers the Duties and Powers of the Hemp Sanitary District Board and to Validate all Proceedings Creating and Establishing the Hemp Sanitary District and to Declare the Coupon Bonds of Said District Valid and Binding Obligations of Said District.
	Ord No. #08-15-2006	The Town, pursuant to G.S. 160A-101 and G.S. 160A-102, amended the Charter to provide that the Town shall operate under the council-manager form of government.
Name Changed	Order	The Town's name was changed from "Hemp" to "Robbins" by Order of the Municipal Control Board filed with the Secretary of State on April 1, 1943.
Section 2	1945-481	Amended Section 2 (corporate limits) by adding certain described territory to the Town's corporate limits.
Section 3	1979-230	Rewrote Section 3 to provide that the Mayor shall serve a four-year term, and the five commissioners shall serve staggered four-year terms.
