Charter	1995-426	An Act to Incorporate the Town of Summerfield, Subject to a Referendum.
Section 2.1	1996-2 Second Extra Session	Rewrote Section 2.1, corporate limits.
	1997-249	Rewrote Section 2.1.
Section 3.3	Ord No. # ???	The Town adopted a resolution of intent to amend Section 3.3 of the Charter to extend the council members' terms from two to four years, and to stagger the terms. *Did Town make this change – check with Town; no ordinance on file with the Secretary of State.
Section 3.4	2008-61	Amended Section 3.4 to provide that vacancies on the Town Council shall be filled as provided by general law.
Section 3.5	Ord No. # 2005-07-05	The Town, following a referendum under G.S. 160A-104, amended Section 3.5 to provide that the Mayor shall be elected for a two-year term by all the qualified voters of the Town and that the Mayor shall vote only in case of a tie. Following the referendum, the Town has a Mayor and five council members.
	Ord No. # 01- 1998-004	The Town, pursuant to G.S. 160A-101 and G.S. 160A-102, amended Section 3.5 of the Charter to provide that the Mayor shall be elected from among the membership of the Town Council at the first organizational meeting after each regular election.
Section 5.1	Ord No. # 2008-01-08	The Town, pursuant to G.S. 160A-101 and G.S. 160A-102, amended Section 5.1 of the Charter to change the form of government from mayor-council to council-manager.
Section 5.3	1999-57	Added Section 5.3, zoning exemption.
