Charter	PrL1891-83	An Act to Amend the Charter of the Town of Weldon, North Carolina.
Section 2	PrL1895-127	Rewrote Section 2, corporate limits.
Section 3	PrL1935-39	Reduce the number of commissioners from seven to four, provided that elections shall be held biennially as provided by general law, and provided for primary elections in the Town *This act did not specifically amend Section 3, but this appears to be the Section that would be amended by this act.
	PL1937-21	Repealed requirement that Town Clerk shall be elected, and made conforming changes. *This act did not specifically amend Section 3, but this appears to be the Section that would be amended by this act.
	1957-148	Amended PrL1935-39 to provide for the election of the mayor and commissioners (qualification for candidacy). *This act did not specifically amend Section 3, but this appears to be the Section that would be amended by this act
	1965-131	Amended PrL1935-39, as amended by PL1937-21 and 1957-148, by increasing the number of commissioners from four to five. *This act did not specifically amend Section 3, but this appears to be the Section that would be amended by this act
	1965-1117	Provided for the time when the Mayor and commissioners shall take office, and when the regular meeting of the board shall be held. *This act did not specifically amend Section 3, but this appears to be the Section that would be amended by this act
Section 15	PrL1901-63	Provided that the board of commissioners may elect a mayor pro tem to serve in the mayor's absence. *This act did not specifically amend Section 15, but this appears to be the Section that would be amended by this act.
	PrL1935-39	Provided for the number of commissioners required for a quorum, and that the Mayor may only vote to break a tie. *This act did not specifically amend Section 15, but this appears to be the Section that would be amended by this act.
Section 17	PrL1907-106	Amended Section 17 by providing that the Town may appropriate funds to support graded schools in the Town.
	PrL1908-52 Extra Session	Added to the commissioners' powers the authority to establish a waterworks and sewerage system. *This act did not specifically amend Section 17, but this appears to be the Section that would be amended by this act.
	PrL1935-39	Provided for the salaries of the Mayor, commissioners, and town clerk. *This act did not specifically amend Section 17,

		but this appears to be the Section that would be amended by this act.
	PrL1935-226	Amended PrL1935-39 to repeal the salaries fixed in that act and to authorize the board of commissioners to fix salaries. *This act did not specifically amend Section 17, but this appears to be the Section that would be amended by this act.
	PL1937-21	Repealed salary provisions for Mayor, commissioners, and town clerk in PrL1935-39 (this language was earlier repealed in PrL1935-226; town clerk no longer elected. *This act did not specifically amend Section 17, but this appears to be the Section that would be amended by this act.
Section 18	PrL1935-39	Provided for the filing of a vacancy in the office of Town Clerk. *This act did not specifically amend Section 18, but this appears to be the Section that would be amended by this act.
	PL1937-21	Repealed vacancy filing requirement in PrL1935-39; Town Clerk no longer elected by Town voters.
Section 29	PrL1901-63	Amended Section 29(6) to provide for the amount of license to sell liquors in the Town. *This act did not specifically amend Section 18, but this appears to be the Section that would be amended by this act.
	PrL1907-106	Rewrote Section 29(6).
	PrL1907-263	Amended the effective date for Section 29(6), as amended by PrL1907-106.
	PrL1913-138	Amended Section 29(1), ad valorem tax, and Section 29(2), poll tax.
