

**The North Carolina Agricultural Foundation, Inc.
NC FFA Foundation State Appropriations annual report
July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022 report**

The funding by the state of North Carolina has provided financial support for the North Carolina FFA Foundation and the North Carolina FFA Center through The North Carolina Agricultural Foundation, Inc. Funding has been used to offset planning for the staff house and the boys' cabins along with renovation costs at the North Carolina FFA Center.

Funds from the 2021-2022 fiscal year were spent to prepare the NC FFA Center to open for campers for the first time since 2019. Specifically, funds were used to provide renovations to the lodge, the alumni building, both piers, the camp store, and rebuild the putt-putt course. Additional funds were used to repair various systems throughout camp including plumbing, electrical, and HVAC. The remainder of the funds were used to provide general maintenance and upkeep at the NC FFA Center.

More than 6,000 students, teachers and government agencies, civic groups and guests continue to utilize the facility annually. Projects at the NC FFA Center directly impact the more than 70,000 students enrolled in Agricultural Education and the more than 600 Agricultural Education teachers in North Carolina.
