

**The North Carolina Agricultural Foundation, Inc.
NC FFA Foundation State Appropriations annual report
July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023 report**

The funding by the state of North Carolina has provided financial support for the North Carolina FFA Foundation and the North Carolina FFA Center through The North Carolina Agricultural Foundation, Inc. Funding has been used to pay for the construction of the staff house and the boys' cabins at the North Carolina FFA Center.

Funds from the 2022-2023 fiscal year were spent to help pay to rebuild the boys' cabins and construct a new staff house at the NC FFA Center. The cabins were completely enclosed with air conditioning and a half bath added for the students. The rebuild also expanded capacity from 15 campers to 16 campers in each of the ten cabins at the NC FFA Center. The new staff house is now a facility that can be used year-round by FFA chapters, summer staff, and community groups.

More than 6,000 students, teachers and government agencies, civic groups, and guests continue to utilize the facility annually. Projects at the NC FFA Center directly impact the more than 70,000 students enrolled in Agricultural Education and the more than 600 Agricultural Education teachers in North Carolina.
