¹ The One North Carolina Fund statute requires that grant agreements include, and grant agreements do include, the ability to recapture funds for a grantee's failure to comply with the agreement. See N.C. Gen. Stat. §143B-437.72(b)(7). Section 2.7 of The Guidelines for One North Carolina, promulgated under the One NC Statute also requires that agreements contain recapture provisions for nonperformance.

ii Job Development Investment Grant Program. The ability to recapture funds for failing to maintain operations at the project location for at least 150% of the grant term is statutorily required to be, and is in fact, reflected in JDIG Agreements. This requirement is also reflected in Section 11.3 of the Criteria for Operation and Implementation of the Job Development Investment Grant Program.

iii The ability to recapture funds for performance failures is statutorily required to be, and is in fact, reflected in the N.C. Green Business Fund grant agreements and Program Guidelines. See §143B-437.6(5).
