Dear Senators Bingham, Blake and Pate:

Section 10.42 of Session Law 2011-145, requires the Department of Health and Human Services to develop a two-year medication therapy management pilot program administered through Community Care of North Carolina (CCNC) to determine the best method of adapting the CheckmedsNC program to Medicaid and CCNC 's medical home, and the most effective and efficient role for community-based pharmacists in CCNC care management teams. A report on these efforts is due January 1, 2012.

To allow for the compilation of a more robust data set to evaluate the progress of this initiative, the Department anticipates submitting the report no later than February 1, 2012.
