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
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Legislative Report on Additional Needs to Survey Abortion Clinics

as

Required by SL 2013-366

Report Findings

Pursuant to S.L. 2013-366 the Division of Health Service Regulation is providing up to date information on the Division's study and identification of resources need to adequately enforce regulations for clinics certified to be suitable to perform abortions.

Contemporaneously with the passage of S.L. 2013-366, the Division of Health Service Regulation was asked to identify its staffing needs to conduct complaints and surveys inspections for uncredentialed hospitals and to monitor abortion clinics on an annual basis. That report, which is attached, identified 10 new positions that would be needed to accomplish the annual survey and complaint investigation workload. As a result of the request an appropriation of \$100,000 was included in S.L. 2013-360. The appropriated amount was to be used in conjunction with receipts in the amount of \$900,000 to totally fund the additional 10 positions. To date the Division has not had success in securing the necessary receipts to create the positions.

The Division's needs remain unchanged—10 new positions will be needed to accomplish the annual survey and complaint investigations workload.
