Session Law 2017-57, Section 11F.2.(b), directs the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities and Substance Abuse Services (MH/DD/SAS), to reduce its allocation for single stream funding for the 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 fiscal years. The Secretary of Health and Human Services is required to submit a proposal to the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Health and Human Services and the Fiscal Research Division on or before March 1, 2018, for any adjustments to the specified recurring reductions among the LME/MCOs for future fiscal years.
