

RE: Requirement to Report Regulatory Flexibility During Declaration of Disaster

Session Law 2024-53, Part 4E, titled "Authorized State Agencies to Exercise Regulatory Flexibility for Employment Related Certifications,") states in section 4E.1.(c), "No later than March 1, 2025, each State agency shall report to the Joint Legislative Administrative Procedure Oversight Committee and the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations on its use of regulatory flexibility under this section."

Accordingly, the North Carolina Sheriffs' Education and Training Standards Commission is reporting that at their November 22, 2024 meeting the Commission approved the following motion, "To approve authorizing staff to grant certification and training extensions for individuals in counties affected by Hurricane Helene in accordance with Session Law 2024-53 (SB 743)."

The Sheriffs' Standards Division which staffs the Sheriffs' Commission notified all of its agencies under its jurisdiction of the above motion approved by the Commission.
