## Headcount of English Learners in North Carolina Public Schools as of November 1, 2022

This report provides the headcount for English Learners (ELs) in North Carolina Public Schools as of November 1, 2022. In accordance with SL 2003-284, Section 7.5(b), the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction (NCDPI) is required to prepare a headcount for all ELs, and per SL 2014-115, sec 86,87, this report is submitted to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee by December 15, of each year.

The current enrollment of those students identified and assessed as English Learners under the State Board of Education (SBE) policies as of November 1, 2022, is 146,141. This number reflects an increase of 14,894 students over last year. The report includes an accompanying table listing the number of students by all Public School Units (PSUs). There are 115 LEAs, 188 charters, nine lab schools, one regional school, and four special schools that have students identified as English Learners. Of these 146,141 students, there are 733 students identified as Academically or Intellectually Gifted (AIG), and 22,069 students identified as having a disability; this includes both students with a Section 504 plan and students with an Individualized Education Program (IEP).

PSU-designated EL Coordinators or EL designees reported the data to NCDPI via the state electronic Student Information System (PowerSchool) and an electronic Pre-K report submission. In adherence with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) (20 U.S.C. § 1232g; 34 CFR Part 99), the data is suppressed where less than ten students are identified as ELs (small cell suppression rule).
