**RE:** Body-Worn Cameras Grant Report

**DATE:** August 1, 2019

*Pursuant to North Carolina Session Law 2018-5, Sections 16.1 and 16.2, the Governor's Crime Commission shall report to the chairs of the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Justice and Public Safety on all grant awards made by the Commission from State funds during the prior fiscal year.
