Dear Senator Berger and Speaker Moore:

Pursuant to Section 16B.2 of the 2017 State Appropriations Act, the State Bureau of Investigation (SBI) participates in the Equitable Sharing of Federally Forfeited Property with the U.S. Department of Justice, and the U.S. Department of Treasury.

On July 9, 2019, the SBI reported our intent to use \$134,400 worth of Federal Forfeiture funds to support the purchase of 230 Apple Watches for sworn investigators. Due to the recurring costs associated with these watches and other deployment issues, the agency has decided not to make that purchase at this time. Instead the SBI reports our intent to use these same funds to support the purchase of larger investigative communication tools (iPads) which can be used in the field in a broader approach to investigative needs. The \$134,400 currently budgeted in special fund 1901-24555-2450-64H5 will now be used to purchase iPad devices for our sworn investigators.

The SBI also reports our intent to use \$25,000 of new asset forfeiture funds to support equipment and specialized training needs pursuant to our annual "Special Agent Academies."

As of November 30, 2019, the SBI Federal Forfeiture Fund had an unencumbered balance of \$602,556.05. If this request to use new funds is approved, the available balance will become \$577,556.05.

Apple Watches: The Apple watch will also serve as the primary means of communication between investigators performing UC assignments and the established command personnel in the command post at large scale events where investigators have been requested for UC and plainclothes work.
