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Outreach Efforts 2022-2023

In collaboration with DPS Communications Office Victim Compensation Services provided webinars in English and Spanish to educate the public of the application process for Crime Victim Compensation. The webinars “How to Apply for Victim Compensation” reached the general public, victims of violent crime and their families, law enforcement agencies, social services, health care providers, other government agencies and community organizations. Victim Compensation Services with Communications continued its outreach awareness, education, and engagement campaign highlighting the programs and resources available to support victims of crime in North Carolina. This is a statewide campaign with objectives to increase public awareness about Victim Compensation Services and to encourage the public to visit the website to learn more. The campaign utilized several outreach opportunities such as social media (Facebook, Instagram and LinkedIn), streaming video ads, digital display ads, news outlets, television, radio, and community involvement (distribution of printed materials). North Carolinians 18+, minority communities, students, and both rural and urban areas were identified among the targeted audience. Assessment of audience engagement indicates that between February-July 2023 76.5 million Victim Compensation Services messages were delivered across a number of platforms and they were viewed 9,126,181 by the audience.
