Governor's Crime Commission Annual Grants Report

Pursuant to N.C.G.S. 143B-1105(b), beginning December 1, 2018, and annually thereafter, the Commission shall report to the chairs of the [Joint Legislative Oversight] Committee on Justice and Public Safety on all grant awards made by the Commission from federal funds during the prior federal fiscal year. The report shall contain all of the following information:

- (1) A list of all federal grants administered in the prior federal fiscal year.
- (2) The names of all entities receiving federal grants.
- (3) The amount, the purpose, and the terms of each grant.
- (4) Whether there are any terms, conditions, or other contingencies that may arise as a result of a freeze on federal funds or result in compliance issues.
- (5) A list of any penalties that have been assessed. The list shall include the entity against which the penalty was assessed, the reason for the assessment, and the source of funds used to pay any penalty.



2024 Annual Report

This annual report may look a little different from previous reports, because GCC is transitioning to a new grant management system. This report had to pull from both the old and the new grant management systems. It includes every project awarded by the Governor's Crime Commission with a period of performance start date between October 1, 2023 through September 30, 2024 as pulled from the new system on October 30, 2024.
