Outreach Efforts 2023-2024

In collaboration with DPS Communications Office the Office of Victim Compensation Services continued its outreach awareness, education, and engagement campaign highlighting the programs and resources available to support victims of crime in North Carolina. This is a statewide campaign with objectives to increase public awareness about Victim Compensation Services and to encourage the public to visit the website to learn more. The campaign utilized several outreach opportunities such as social media (Facebook, Instagram and LinkedIn), streaming video ads, digital display ads, news outlets, television, radio, and community involvement (distribution of printed materials). North Carolinians 18+, minority communities, students, and both rural and urban areas were identified among the targeted audience.

Additionally, development of an online application portal in collaboration with NC DIT staff and Mainstreet Computing has begun with an expected implementation date in early 2025. This online portal will assist in reducing barriers to victims and their families submitting compensation claim applications. Applications may be submitted using technology such as computers, Ipads, and cell phones.
