Issuance of Special Indebtedness (Build NC Bonds) by the State of North Carolina

This report is submitted to the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations regarding the upcoming issuance by the State of North Carolina (the "State") of special indebtedness in the form of Build NC Bonds to provide funding for Build NC Projects (as each such term is defined in the Act described below) pursuant to the provisions of the State Capital Facilities Finance Act, Article 9 of Chapter 142 of the North Carolina General Statutes, as previously amended and as amended by SL 2018-16 (collectively, the "Act").

Build NC Bonds are to be issued in an amount not to exceed \$300,000,000 for the purpose of financing various Build NC Projects, including but not limited to those reflected on Appendix A attached hereto.

On May 23, 2019 the Council of State, pursuant to G.S. 142-84(b) and (c), adopted resolutions granting preliminary and final approval of the financing through the issuance of special indebtedness in the form of Build NC Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$300,000,000 for the purpose of (1) providing partial funding for the "costs" (as such term is defined in the Act) of Build NC Projects, including but not limited to those reflected on Appendix A attached hereto and (2) paying certain costs associated with the issuance thereof. The State intends to issue State of North Carolina Limited Obligation (Build NC) Bonds, Series 2019A (the "2019A Bonds") pursuant to the Act.

A Preliminary Official Statement, describing the 2019A Bonds, the Build NC Projects anticipated to be financed with proceeds of the 2019A Bonds and the State and its finances, will be distributed to potential purchasers of the 2019A Bonds shortly. The 2019A Bonds are anticipated to be issued in June, 2019.
