A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO CLARIFY THAT REFUSAL TO DELIVER PROPERTY TO A
2 PERSON HOLDING A LIEN OR SECURITY INTEREST IN THE PROPERTY
3 OR TO A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER PURSUANT TO A JUDICIAL
4 ORDER IS A CRIMINAL OFFENSE.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. G.S. 14-115 reads as rewritten:

8 "**§ 14-115. Secreting property to hinder enforcement of lien or security interest.**

9 Any person removing, ~~exchanging or secreting~~ exchanging, secreting, or refusing to
10 deliver to the holder of the lien or security interest or to a law enforcement officer any
11 personal property on which a lien or security interest exists, after a judgment or order
12 for possession for that property has been issued, with intent to prevent or hinder the
13 enforcement of the lien or security interest, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable
14 by a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00), imprisonment for not more than
15 six months, or both."

16 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective October 1, 1989, and shall apply to
17 offenses occurring on or after that date.
