1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH
2 COMMISSION FOR A STUDY OF CAMPAIGN AND ELECTION
3 PROCEDURES.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study the issue of
7 campaign and election procedure. It may report to the 1991 General Assembly the
8 results of the study, and it may make an interim report to the 1989 General Assembly,
9 Regular Session 1990.

10 Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Legislative
11 Research Commission the sum of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) for the 1989-90
12 fiscal year and the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for the 1990-91 fiscal year to
13 implement Section 1 of this act.

14 Sec. 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
