**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH PROGRAMS AND SERVICES.**

Whereas, a safe and healthy environment is of paramount importance to economic growth and development; and

Whereas, a wide variety of necessary environmental health programs and services have been mandated by the General Assembly, many of which have been delegated to local government; and

Whereas, resources to carry out these and other vital environmental health services are not currently available; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Human Resources, Division of Health Services, the sum of three million eight hundred thousand dollars (\$3,800,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year and the sum of three million eight hundred thousand dollars (\$3,800,000) for the 1990-91 fiscal year to provide high-quality environmental health programs and services at the local level to the people of the State.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
