AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR APPEAL TO THE COMM

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR APPEAL TO THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE OF DECISIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNING BOARD OR OTHER EXECUTIVES OF THE NORTH CAROLINA RATE BUREAU REGARDING THE PROPRIETY OF INSURER DETERMINATIONS THAT INSUREDS ARE AT FAULT IN MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 58-124.24 reads as rewritten:

"§ 58-124.24. Appeal to Commissioner from decision of Bureau.

- (a) Any member of the Bureau may appeal to the Commissioner from any decision of the Bureau and the Commissioner shall, after a hearing held on not less than 10 days' written notice to the appellant and to the Bureau, issue an order approving the decision of the Bureau or directing it to give further consideration to such proposal. In the event the Bureau fails to take satisfactory action, the Commissioner shall make such order as he may see fit.
- (b) Decisions made by the governing committee or other proper executive of the Bureau pursuant to G.S. 58-124.17(2) as to whether an insurer made an erroneous determination that an operator of an insured vehicle was at fault in a motor vehicle accident may be appealed by the insured or the insurer to the Commissioner. Upon the issuance of a decision, the Bureau shall notify the parties to the proceeding of the decision and of their right to appeal that decision to the Commissioner.

On appeal of the decision to the Commissioner, at least 10 days notice shall be given to the appellant and the Bureau. Notice shall include a statement of the date, hour, place, and nature of the hearing. The Commissioner shall issue an order approving or

disapproving the decision. In the event the Commissioner disapproves the decision, he
shall direct the Bureau to take such action as he deems appropriate.
Review of the Commissioner's order may be made pursuant to G.S. 58-9.3."
Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
Insurance the sum of sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year for the
purpose of hiring an appeals referee and support staff necessary to implement this act.
Sec. 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
