4 UNIVERSITY TRUST FUNDS IN CERTAIN COMPANIES THAT WERE
5 DOING BUSINESS IN SOUTH AFRICA.
6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7 Section 1. Chapter 446 of the 1987 Session Laws is repealed.
8 Sec. 2. Chapter 1070 of the 1987 Session Laws is repealed.
9 Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
