1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE RESTORATION OF THE
3 CAROLINA THEATRE IN GREENSBORO.

4 Whereas, the Carolina Theatre serves as the major performing arts center in
5 Greensboro and the surrounding area; and

6 Whereas, the Carolina Theatre produces over fifty cultural and entertainment
7 events each year and is used an average of 230 days per year by a total of more than
8 thirty local cultural arts groups; and

9 Whereas, the Carolina Theatre is of great historic significance and is listed on
10 the National Register of Historic Places; and

11 Whereas, preservation of this historic property and its upfitting and repair can
12 no longer be delayed; and

13 Whereas, the Greensboro community has contributed over three million
14 dollars to its restoration; Now, therefore,

15 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

16 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the United Arts
17 Council of Greensboro, Inc., the sum of \$20,000 for the 1989-90 fiscal year to facilitate
18 the restoration of the Carolina Theatre in Greensboro, Guilford County.

19 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
