A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR A RURAL SCHOOL-BASED 3 ENTERPRISE PROGRAM.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to North Carolina 6 REAL Enterprises, Inc., the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 7 1989-90 fiscal year and the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 8 1990-91 fiscal year for North Carolina's Rural School-Based Enterprise Program, a 9 program in which rural students will research, plan, set up, operate, and own 10 economically viable small businesses in cooperation with local educational institutions. 11 These funds shall be used as follows:

- 12(1)Two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal13year and two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 1990-1491 fiscal year shall be used to support teachers and program operations15at 10 pilot sites across the State;
- 16(2)One hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal17year and one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) for the 1990-1891 fiscal year shall be used to sustain the technical assistance, training,19and management support provided by North Carolina REAL20Enterprises, Inc., at no cost to participating pilot sites; and
- (3) One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year
 and one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 1990-91 fiscal
 year shall be used to expand the capital pool through which North
