18 Sec. 2. The additional judge authorized by Section 1 of this act shall be 19 appointed by the Governor from nominations submitted by the bar of the judicial district 20 as defined in G.S. 84-19. The appointee shall serve until a successor, elected in the 21 general election of November 1990, takes office on the first Monday in December 1990, 22 to serve a four-year term.

Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial Department \$87,339 for the 1989-90 fiscal year and \$84,562 for the 1990-91 fiscal year to implement this act.

Sec. 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
