1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE NORTH CAROLINA SYMPHONY
2 FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF AN AUDIO-VISUAL EDUCATIONAL
3 PROGRAM.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
7 Cultural Resources for the North Carolina Symphony Society, Inc., \$100,000 for the
8 1989-90 fiscal year to be used to develop, maintain, and update an ongoing audio-visual
9 program and a young people's television series, for the North Carolina Symphony's
10 statewide education outreach effort that can be used with current written materials and
11 recordings in the school systems in all counties of the State by all six of the major
12 orchestras operating current education programs. These funds are in addition to those
13 appropriated to the North Carolina Symphony by the Current Operations Appropriations
14 Act and shall become part of the department's continuing budget.

15 Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
