A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO RAISE THE PER DIEM PAYMENTS FOR
STATE INMATES IN COUNTY JAILS.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Correction the sum of \$2,267,543 for the 1990-91 fiscal year to raise the per diem reimbursement to counties from twelve dollars and fifty cents (\$12.50) per day to twenty dollars (\$20.00) per day for State inmates serving sentences of more than 30 days in local confinement facilities.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1990.
