A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO AMEND THE MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS FOR THE BOARD
2 OF GOVERNORS OF THE NORTH CAROLINA MOTOR VEHICLE
3 REINSURANCE FACILITY.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 58-248.33(d) reads as rewritten:

7 "(d) The Facility shall be administered by a Board of Governors. The Board of
8 Governors shall consist of ~~nine~~ 12 members having one vote each from the
9 classifications hereinafter enumerated plus the Commissioner who shall serve ex officio
10 without vote. Each Facility insurance company member serving on the Board shall be
11 represented by a senior officer of the company. Not more than one company in a group
12 under the same ownership or management shall be represented on the Board at the same
13 time. Five members of the Board shall be selected by the member insurers, which
14 members shall be fairly representative of the industry. To insure representative member
15 insurers, one each shall be selected from the following groups: the American Insurance
16 Association (or its successors), the ~~American Mutual Insurance Alliance~~ Alliance of
17 American Insurers (or its successors), the National Association of Independent Insurers
18 (or its successors), all other stock insurers not affiliated with the above groups, and all
19 other nonstock insurers not affiliated with the above groups. The Commissioner shall
20 appoint two members of the Board who shall be Facility insurance company members
21 domiciled in this State. The Commissioner shall appoint one member of the Board who
22 shall be selected from a list of two nominees submitted by the Auto Insurance Agents of
23 North Carolina, Inc. The Commissioner of Insurance shall appoint four members of the
24 Board who shall be fire and casualty insurance agents licensed in this State and actively

1 engaged in writing motor vehicle insurance in this State. The Commissioner shall select
2 one agent from among a list of two nominees submitted by the Independent Insurance
3 Agents of North Carolina, Inc., and one agent from among a list of two nominees
4 submitted by the Carolinas Association of Professional Insurance Agents. The initial
5 term of office of said Board members shall be two years. Following completion of
6 initial terms, successors to the members of the original Board of Governors shall be
7 selected to serve three years. All members of the Board of Governors shall serve until
8 their successors are selected and qualified and the Commissioner may fill any vacancy
9 on the Board from any of the aforementioned classifications until such vacancies are
10 filled in accordance with the provisions of this Article. The Board of Governors of the
11 Facility shall also have as nonvoting members two persons who are not employed by or
12 affiliated with any insurance company or the Department of Insurance and who are
13 appointed by the Governor to serve at his pleasure."

14 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
