A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO PROVIDE FOR EXPANSION OF THE  
2 OYSTER REHABILITATION PROGRAM, INITIATION OF A SHELLFISH  
3 GROWOUT PROGRAM, AND ACQUISITION OF A LAND-BASED  
4 ENFORCEMENT AIRCRAFT.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of  
8 Natural Resources and Community Development, Division of Marine Fisheries, the sum  
9 of four hundred thirteen thousand four hundred seventy-one dollars (\$413,471) for the  
10 1989-90 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred fifty-five thousand four hundred  
11 seventy-one dollars (\$155,471) for the 1990-91 fiscal year, to expand the capabilities of  
12 the oyster rehabilitation program by adding a second shallow draft vessel to transplant  
13 oyster stocks.

14 Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of  
15 Natural Resources and Community Development, Division of Marine Fisheries, the sum  
16 of seven hundred seventy-five thousand seven hundred eighteen dollars (\$775,718) for  
17 the 1989-90 fiscal year and the sum of two hundred twenty-four thousand two hundred  
18 eighty-two dollars (\$224,282) for the 1990-91 fiscal year, to initiate a program for  
19 shellfish enhancement through development and application of modern aquaculture  
20 techniques.

21 Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of  
22 Natural Resources and Community Development, Division of Marine Fisheries, the sum  
23 of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year and the sum of

1 twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000) for the 1990-91 fiscal year, to purchase a single  
2 engine land-based aircraft for night surveillance operations and patrol of closed harvest  
3 areas and polluted shellfish areas.

4           Sec. 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
