A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT ALL SWORN LAW-ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS IN
THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES ARE ENTITLED TO THE BENEFITS
OF THE SALARY CONTINUATION PLAN FOR CERTAIN STATE LAW-
ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 143-166.13(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) The following persons who are subject to the Criminal Justice Training and
Standards Act are entitled to benefits under this Article:

- (1) State Government Security Officers, Department of Administration;
- (2) State Correctional Officers, Department of Corrections;
- (3) State Probation and Parole Officers, Department of Corrections;
- (4) Sworn State Law-Enforcement Officers with the power of arrest,
Department of Corrections;
- (5) Alcohol Law-Enforcement Agents, Department of Crime Control and
Public Safety;
- (6) State Highway Patrol Officers, Department of Crime Control and
Public Safety;
- (7) State Legislative Building Special Police, General Assembly;
- (8) Sworn State Law-Enforcement Officers with the power of arrest,
Department of Human Resources;
- (9) Youth Correctional Officers, Department of Human Resources;
- (10) Insurance Investigators, Department of Insurance;

- 1 (11) State Bureau of Investigation Officers and Agents, Department of
2 Justice;
- 3 (12) Director and Assistant ~~Director~~Directors, License and Theft
4 Enforcement Section, Division of Motor Vehicles, Department of
5 Transportation;
- 6 (13) ~~Members of License and Theft Enforcement Section~~Sworn State Law-
7 Enforcement Officers with the power of arrest, Enforcement Section,
8 Division of Motor Vehicles, Department of Transportation, designated
9 by the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles as either "inspectors" or uniformed
10 weigh station personnel;
- 11 (14) Utilities Commission Transportation Inspectors and Special
12 Investigators;
- 13 (15) North Carolina Ports Authority Police, Department of Commerce;
- 14 (16) Sworn State Law-Enforcement Officers with the power of arrest,
15 Department of Natural Resources and Community Development;
- 16 (17) Sworn State Law-Enforcement Officers with the power of arrest,
17 Department of Crime Control and Public Safety."
- 18 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
