CHAPTER 107
HOUSE BILL 918

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE CITY OF WILSON TO SCHEDULE REFERENDA ON
CHARTER AMENDMENTS BY ORDINANCE ON THE SAME DATE AS THE
REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Notwithstanding G.S. 160A-103, any election in the City of Wilson held under that section as the result of a referendum petition submitted under that section between March 1, 1989, and June 1, 1989, shall be held at the same time as the regular 1989 municipal election. If any ordinance subject to such referendum petition affecting the election of city officers is approved by the voters at that election, it shall, as provided by G.S. 160A-109, become effective beginning with officers elected in 1991.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 16th day of May, 1989.
