A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE SMALL FARM  
HORTICULTURAL MARKETING PROJECT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to North Carolina Coalition of Farm and Rural Families the sum of \$750,000 for the 1990-91 fiscal year to implement its Small Farm Horticultural Marketing Project, to assist in marketing horticultural products grown in rural North Carolina. No more than thirty-five percent (35%) of the funds appropriated may be used for administrative expenses. The North Carolina Coalition of Farm and Rural Families shall report quarterly to the Joint Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations on the use of these funds.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1990.
