A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO PROVIDE FOR MINIMUM LIFEGUARD
COVERAGE AT EXISTING SWIMMING BEACHES AND POOLS IN THE
STATE PARKS SYSTEM.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Natural Resources and Community Development, Division of Parks and Recreation, the sum of fifty-eight thousand one hundred one dollars (\$58,101) for the 1989-90 fiscal year and the sum of fifty-eight thousand one hundred thirty-eight dollars (\$58,138) for the 1990-91 fiscal year to hire additional seasonal lifeguards to provide minimum compliance with safety regulations at existing swimming beaches and pools within the State Parks System.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
